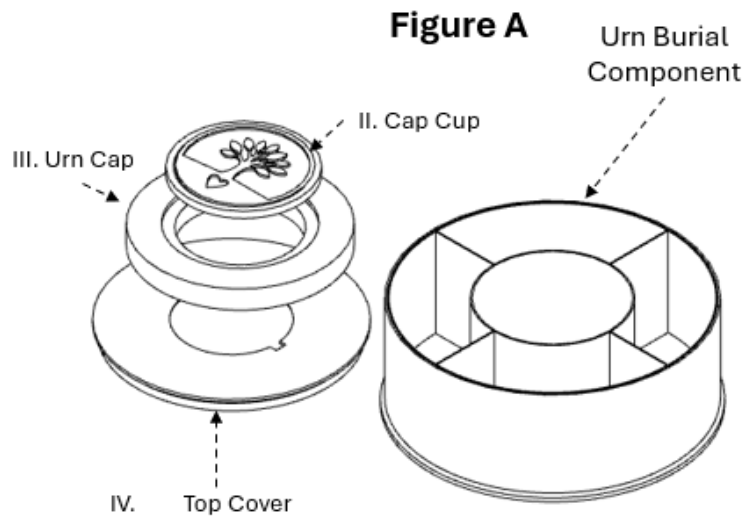




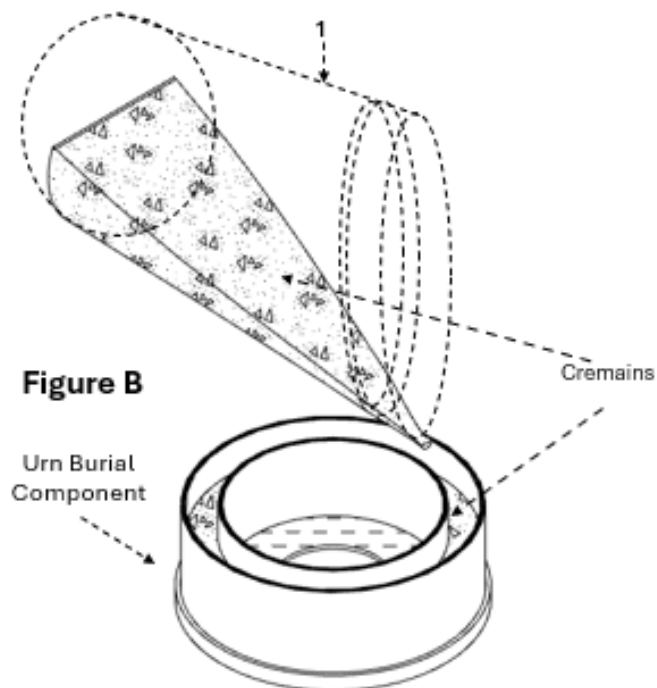
REPAIR PLANTURN FOR INTERMENT AND PLANTING

Before interment, the Assembled PlantUrn needs to be reconfigured to create the Urn Interment Component that will be the final holder of the cremains . *Note: This process should be started after the cremains have been received. (See [Cremation Process Instructions](#))*

Step 1: *Figure A* Prepare The Urn for interment by removing the top component Parts II. through IV. from the Urn Burial Component ASSEMBLY.



Step 2: *Figure B* Empty the cremains from cremains Bag (1) into the Urn Burial Component between the inner and outer rings.





PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Figure 1 You will need a planting trowel (*i*), a spade shovel (*ii*), a 5 Gallon pail (*iii*), work gloves (*iv*). A tree or plant seedling. These items are Not Included with the PlantURN.

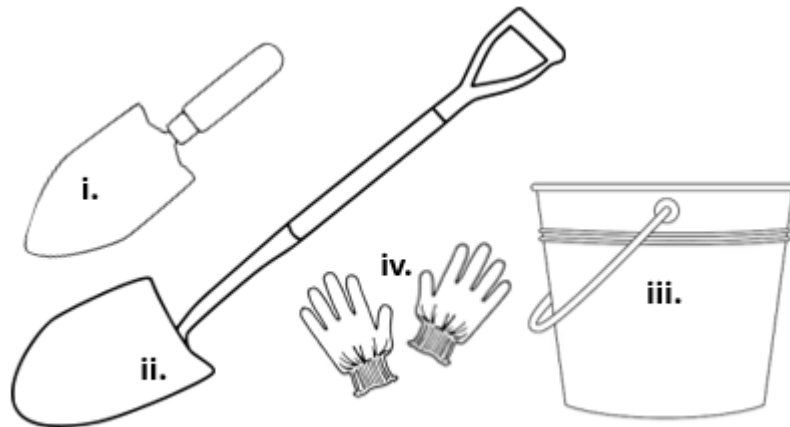

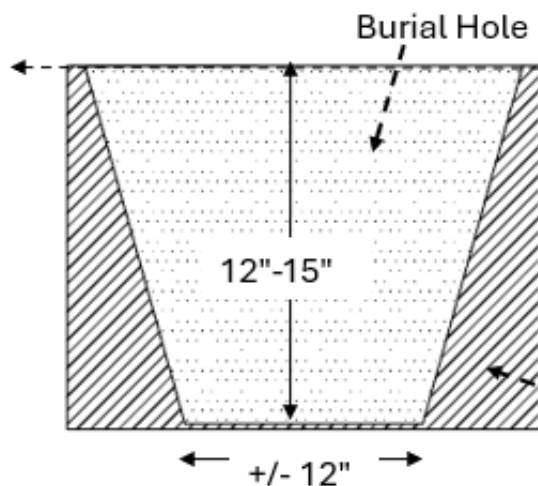
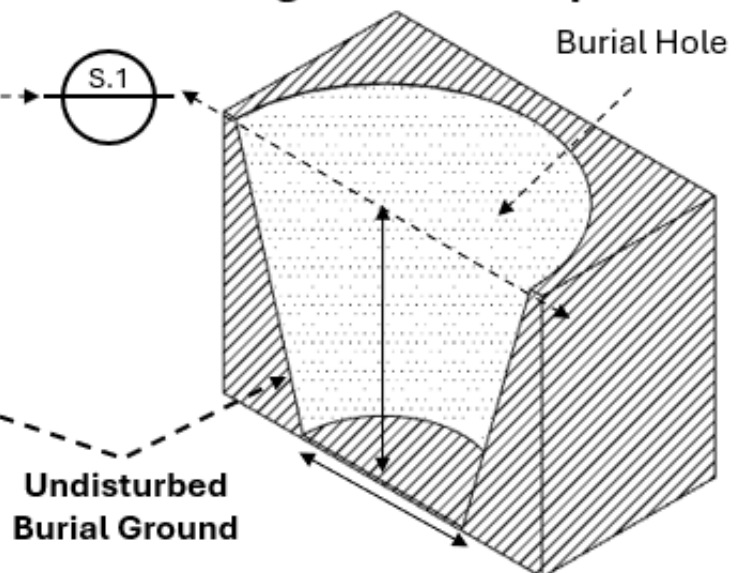
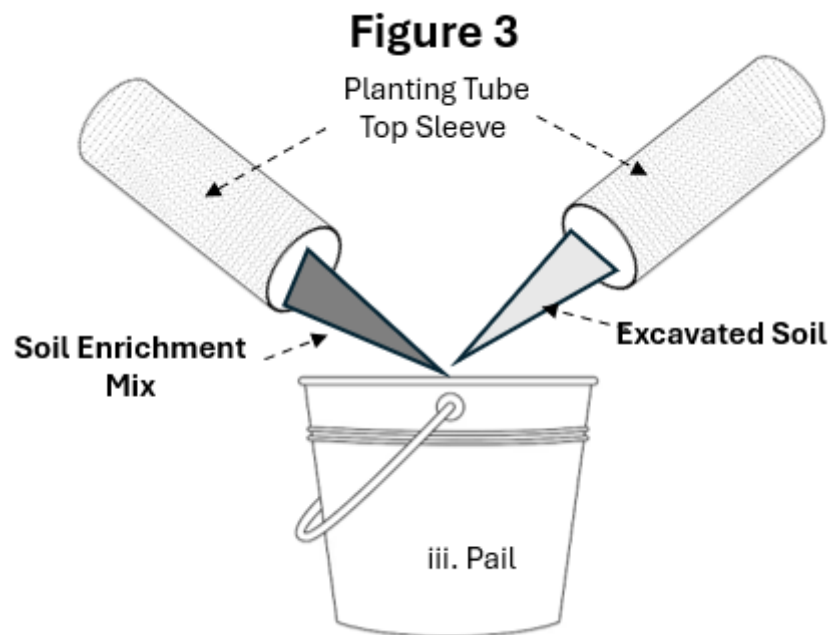


Figure 2.2 - Perspective

Step 2: Figures 2.1 and 2.2 Prepare the ground in which the Urn Interment Component is to be placed by digging a hole 12" to 18" deep with sides tapering up from a +/- 12" diameter hole bottom. Set the excavated soil aside to be used in the backfill process after the interment ceremony.

Figure 2.1 - Side View

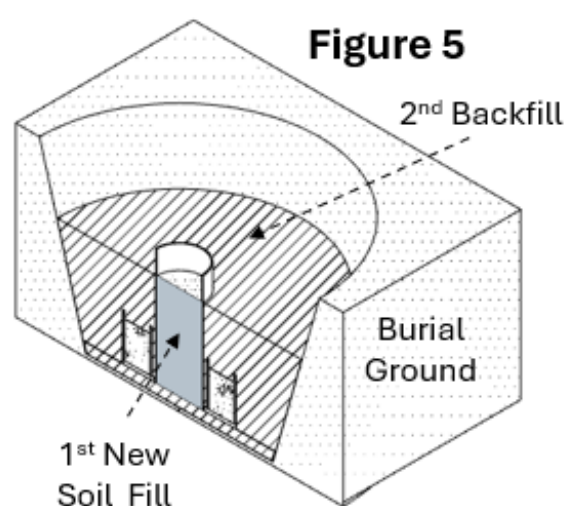
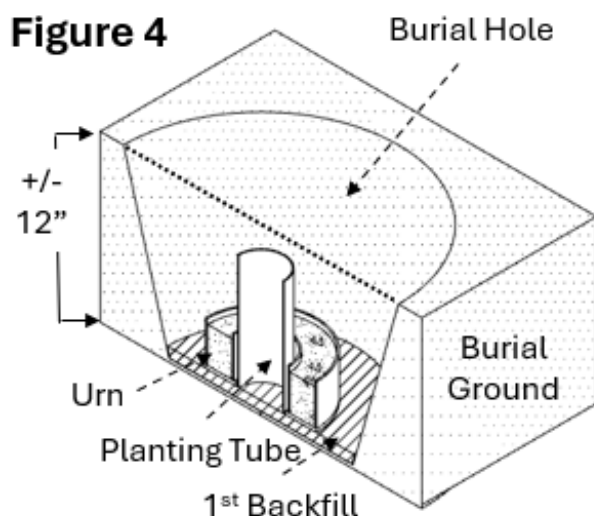


Step 3: *Figure 3* Using the Planting Tube to measure, add +/- 4 Tubes of excavated dirt to the pail and mix thoroughly with an equal amount of commercial planting soil such as Miracle-Gro Tree and shrub Garden soil or equivalent. (Not included) . Set pail aside.

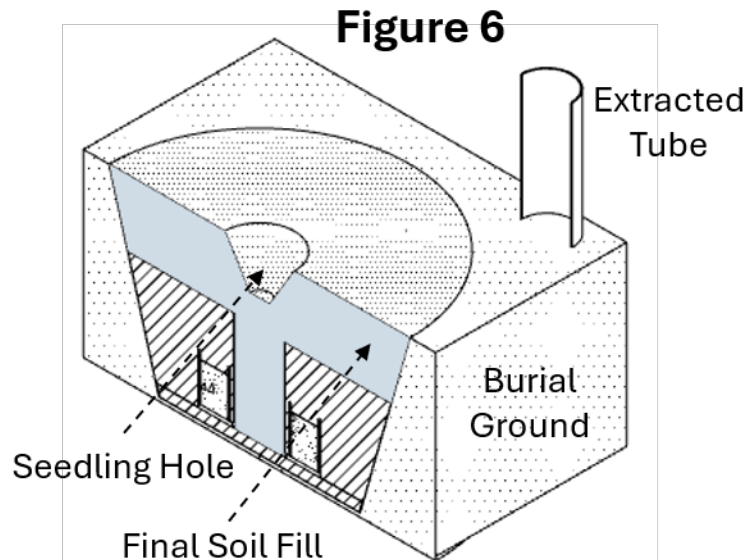


Step 4: *Figure 4* Place +/- 1" of excavated dirt into the bottom of the Burial Hole. (1st Backfill). Then place the Urn on the top of the 1st Backfill dirt. Check that the Urn is level. Next, pour about ½ gallon of water over the top of the urn to moisten the urn components and 1st Backfill dirt. Next, place the Planting Tube onto the backfill dirt so that it is centered inside the urn.

Step 5: *Figure 5* Place excavated dirt into the Burial Hole up to the top of the Urn (2nd Backfill). Then fill the Planting Tube with New Soil Mixture from Step 3. (1st New Soil Fill) Leave 1 to 2 inches of space at the top of the Tube.

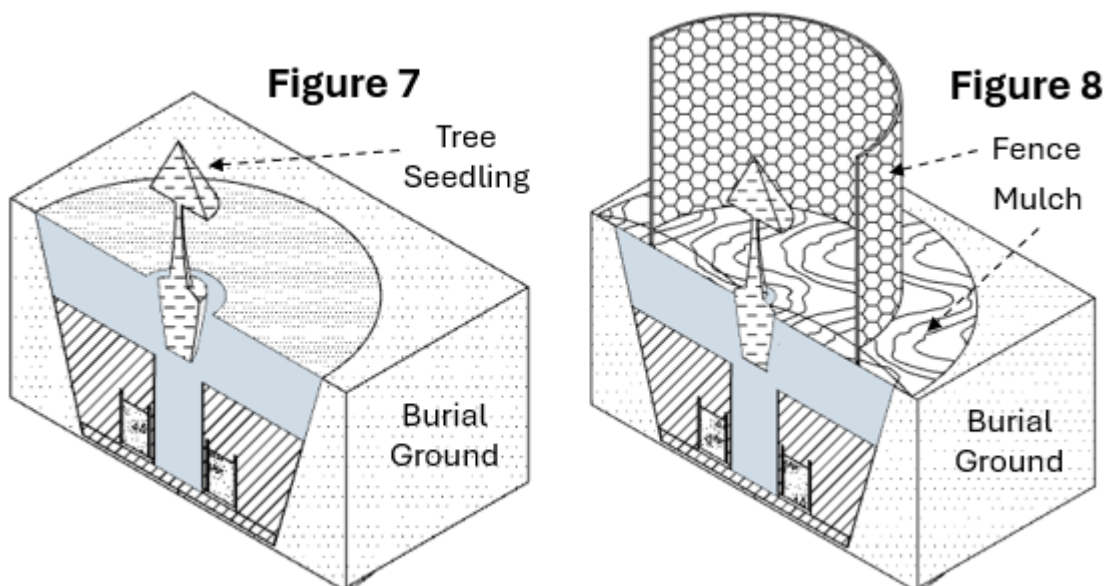


Step 6: *Figure 6* Remove the Planting Tube from the ground and set it aside for disposal. Fill the remaining Burial Hole with New Soil mixture. Leave a sloped “Seedling Hole” depression in which to plant the plant or tree seedling you have selected to memorialize your pet. (*Final Soil Fill*).



Step 7: *Figure 7* Gently place the tree or plant seedling into the Seedling Hole and top off the seedling hole with enriched soil to a level slightly over the top of the seedling root ball. Lightly compress the soil.

STEP 8 : *Figure 8* Place mulch (NOT SUPPLIED WITH PLANTURN) over the planting surface to about a 1 inch depth. Ensure that the mulch is pulled back from the seedling stem. Water as directed by your seedling supplier. We also suggest placing a mesh fence around your seedling during early stages of growth to protect the young growth plant from pests.



When planted as directed your seedling is well positioned for healthy root growth.
